**The week is full of emotions and friendship.**

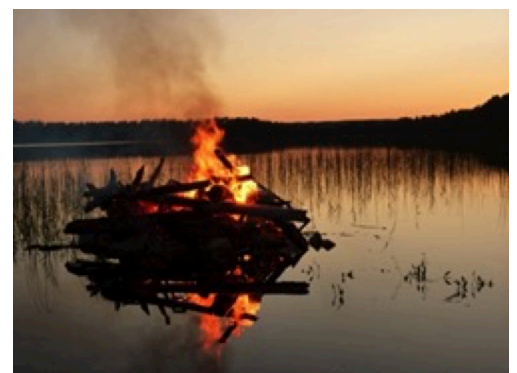
It is a week full of old and new friends from many countries, with many languages & generations; simply a mixture of everything and that makes it very special. Join and you'll see that these words are not only empty promises.

If your 1<sup>st</sup> reunion is within 5 years since your exchange it is possible to **receive a subsidy of 160 CHF** to cover at least a part of the cost for attending the IFYE reunion. The subsidy is currently authorised to run until 2024.
