It is the oldest still running glass village in Finland. Glass has been manufactured in Nuutajärvi since 1793, longer than anywhere else in Finland. The Glass village is the home of the largest community of independent glass designers and glassblowers with their own shops, studios and galleries in Finland. We enjoyed making our own glass birds. Some of us got to know the Nuutajärvi manor. Of course we heated a sauna in the meeting!

Mänttä Club has been used as an event venue, a meeting place for many notable people, a stage for wrestling matches and even as a war time hospital.
